

## SIGNS OF THE TIMES IN TIMOTHY

### I. I. DEPARTURE FROM THE FAITH/DECLARING THE FAITH

**1TI 4:1** Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;

**1TI 4:2** Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;

**1TI 4:3** Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.

**1TI 4:4** For every creature of God is good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving:

**1TI 4:5** For it is sanctified by the word of God and prayer.

### II. II. DOTING ABOUT/DOCTRINALY ABOUNDING

**1TI 6:3** If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness;

**1TI 6:4** He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings,

**1TI 6:5** Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself.

**1TI 1:4** Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do.

**1TI 1:6** From which some having swerved have turned aside unto vain jangling;

**2TI 3:1** This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

**2TI 3:2** For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

**2TI 3:4** Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;

**VI. DENY THE POWER OF GODLINESS/DENOUNCE  
UNGODLINESS**

**2TI 3:5** Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

**VII. DECEIVED PEOPLE SEEKING RELIGIOUS  
SALVE/DISCIPLINED FOLLOWERS SEEKING TRUTH**

**2TI 4:3** For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;

**2TI 4:4** And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.

**VI. CONCL: 1COR.15:58**

**1CO 15:58** Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.
